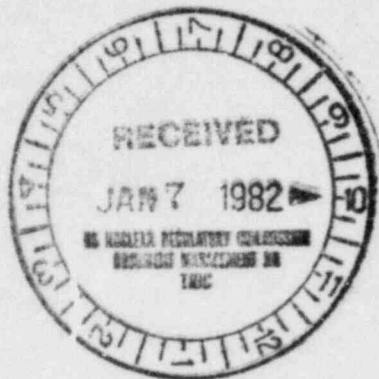

Gentlemen:

Subject: Notice of Violation

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. S. R. Lasuk of this office on November 4, 1981, of activities at 25304 Farmington Road in Farmington Hills, Michigan and to the discussion of our findings with Mrs. Carolyn Bindon at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection revealed that you possess sixty (60) gunsights, each containing 160 millicuries of hydrogen-3 (tritium) and that you had been distributing such gunsights since March or April of 1981 without a specific NRC license. Your possession of that material without a valid, specific license is a violation of Section 30.3, 10 CFR Part 30. Section 30.3 states:

"30.3 Activities requiring license. Except for persons exempt as provided in this part and Part 150 of this chapter, no person shall manufacture, produce, transfer, receive, acquire, own, possess, or use, byproduct material except as authorized in a specific or general license issued pursuant to the regulations in this chapter."

We contacted Mr. John W. N. Hickey of the NRC Material Licensing Branch regarding this matter and, it is our understanding that he informed you that you cannot possess radioactive material without a valid NRC license; this was then confirmed in Mr. Hickey's letter to Leadership Keys, Inc., dated October 13, 1981.

It is our understanding that as of November 4, 1981, you ceased distribution of gunsights containing radioactive material and that you will not resume distribution until you are issued a license to do so by the NRC. This understanding was confirmed in a telephone conversation between you and Messrs. D. J. Sreniawski and S. R. Lasuk of my staff on November 12, 1981 and in our Confirmatory Action Letter to you dated November 13, 1981.

During a subsequent visit to 25304 Farmington Road by Mr. Lasuk on December 14, 1981, it was confirmed that you complied with the action described in our November 13, 1981 letter.

This Notice of Violation is sent to you under the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Section 2.201 requires you to submit to this office, within twenty (20) days of your receipt of this notice, a written statement or explanation in reply including: (1) corrective steps which have been taken by you, and (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid this happening in the future.

In your reply to this notice, please include the name and address of all persons to whom you distributed gunsights containing radioactive material and the number of such gunsights each person received.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and your reply will be placed in the Public Document Room.

We request that you give prompt attention to these matters. Should you have any questions concerning them, we will be pleased to discuss them with you.
