 SUBJECT: RESIDENT PROGRAM REPORT, MID-SEPTEMBER

As of September 15, 1980, IE had 136 residents or their equivalents on 79 sites. Another 11 residents had been selected and will be reporting on site during the next 6 months: 3 in September, 4 in October, 3 in November and 1 in March 1981.

There are still 11 positions for which no selections have been made. These consist of 5 senior resident positions (i.e., Fitzpatrick/Nine Mile Point, Yankee Rowe, Sequoyah, Dresden, Cooper), and 5 resident positions (i.e., Indian Point, Millstone, Shoreham, Hatch, Brunswick). There are 8 residents "in surplus"---where there are more residents on site than required by the latest Commission guidance and as directed in Mr. Moseley's memorandum of August 21, 1980. These are at Vermont Yankee, Yankee Rowe, Browns Ferry, Oconee, Dresden, Big Rock Point, LaCrosse, and Monticello.



A number of unusual items should be noted:

- The sites not yet manned by a senior resident, resident, or equivalent resident are Cooper and Riverbend. There is a designee for Riverbend expected on site in October.
- The B&W fuel facility site will be closed down in October 1980.
- The WPPS 2 site was listed as an operating site during most of FY 1980. It has now become a construction site and will be manned through most of FY 1981.
- The WPPS 1,4 site was manned as a construction site through June. The resident at this site has been temporarily shifted to WPPS 2 and will return to WPPS 1,4 by the end of FY 1981.
- The Phipps Bend site was to be manned as a construction site but progress at this site does not warrant such manning until FY 1981.
- Two more senior residents are leaving this week:

Bill Cottle (Sequoyah) and Jimmy Barker (Dresden). By my rough count we have lost, through promotion or turnover, another 5 senior residents since the program began. Plus one senior resident on loan to the Spanish.

Subject: RESIDENT INSPECTION PROGRAM

Purpose: To inform the Commission of the selection of eight sites for initial manning by Resident Inspectors.

Discussion: The initial selection of sites for resident inspectors has been made using the following criteria:

- Involvement of all Regions.
- Mix of facilities in the three phases--operations, preoperational testing, and construction.
- Mix of sites with high and low numbers of real or apparent problems.
- Available heavy workload to permit inspectors to build an experience base as rapidly as possible.
- Mix of types of reactors.

The eight sites selected for the beginning of the Resident Inspection Program are:

Salem  
Browns Ferry  
North Anna  
D. C. Cook  
Midland  
Arkansas Nuclear 1  
San Onofre

The chosen facilities represent a good cross section for gaining diverse experience during the early stages of the Resident Inspection Program. This experience will contribute greatly to the final program development, and it was considered vital that the selections be made representative of the spectrum of conditions that may be encountered later.

Subject: RESIDENT INSPECTION PROGRAM

Purpose: To inform the Commission of the selection of twelve additional sites for manning by resident inspectors during fiscal year 1978.

Discussion: The selection of additional sites for resident inspectors has been made using the same criteria as the initial eight site selections (SECY-77-138B):

- Involvement of all Regions.
- Mix of facilities in the three phases--operations, preoperational testing, and construction.
- Mix of sites with high and low numbers of real or apparent problems.
- Available heavy workload to permit inspectors to build an experience base as rapidly as possible.
- Mix of types of reactors.


