
All Power Reactor Licensees and Applicants with Docketed Applications
to Construct or Operate a Power Reactor

Gentlemen:

This letter and enclosed NUREG 0219, Draft 2 are being sent to all licensees authorized to operate a nuclear power reactor and to all applicants with applications for a license to operate or construct a power reactor.

NUREG 0219 outlines the current position of the NRR staff on implementation of the requirement to upgrade the qualification, training and equipping of security personnel.
