Even though construction is in progress, I am against having the project completed and licensed.

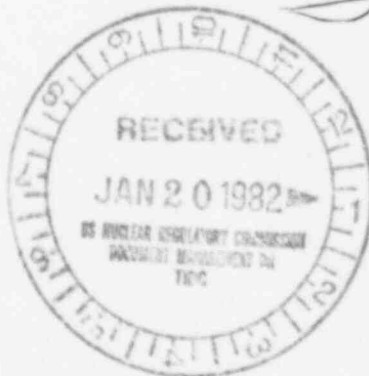
