Subject: Confirmation of Action

This refers to a telephone conversation on November 2, 1981, between Mr. J. T. Beckham, Jr., of your staff and Mr. R. C. Lewis of this office concerning our evaluation of the Full-Scale Emergency Exercise of October 21-22, 1981, at the E. I. Hatch facility. Our findings were also discussed on October 22, 1981, by Mr. D. L. Andrews of this office with Mr. J. T. Beckham, Jr., Vice President and General Manager-Nuclear Generation, and Mr. M. Manry, Plant Manager.

With regard to matters discussed, it is our understanding that you have undertaken or will undertake the following actions to resolve apperent deficiencies in your emergency preparedness program:

- Reassess the Plant Manager's role with respect to command and control functional responsibilities within the onsite emergency organization.
- Assign onshift responsibility for emergency notifications and provide enhanced training for the assigned individuals to include actions to be taken to verify message receipt when the Emergency Notification Network (ENN) system fails to operate.
- Clarify the command and control functions of the Technical Support Center (TSC) in accordance with the criteria of NUREG-0654 and guidance in NUREG-0696. Increase TSC staffing to relieve engineering support personnel from communications functions.
- 4. Assign management supervisor to the Operational Support Center (OSC) who will be readily available to assume control of OSC functions, and provide staffing to include health physics support personnel at the OSC. Additionally, equip the OSC with appropriate emergency equipment and supplies, such as survey instruments, protective clothing, etc.

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- 5. Resolve differences between the State of Georgia and Georgia Power Company's offsite dose calculational models and strengthen the interface between the State and Georgia Power with respect to Georgia Power Company's role in providing information necessary for protective action decision making.
- 6. Submit a written report to the Director, Region II, by December 1, 1981, describing actions taken in the above areas and, for those actions not complete, providing the completion dates. It is our understanding that these actions will be completed prior to March 1, 1982.

Please inform this office immediately if your understanding of this matter is different from that stated above.
