

MEMORANDUM TO THE FILE:

PROPOSED LICENSE TO EXPORT NUCLEAR COMPONENTS TO BELGIUM (XCOMO587) SUBJECT:

On January 6, 1982 Westinghouse Electric Corporation filed an application to export specially designed parts and components for use in the start-up assembly in the Tihange 1 nuclear power reactor. Westinghouse has requested by telephone expeditious processing of this export license application as the components are ready for immediate shipment and are urgently required by the customer.

The staff has concluded that the proposed export meets the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act, as amended, and would not be inimical to the common defense and security of the United States.

In view of the above considerations, the staff issued this license without the normal 15-day waiting period.
