Dear Mr. Collins:

By Reference 1 you requested the District to advise you as to the earliest date that you may expect to receive copies of the revised Emergency Plan and Implementing Procedures for Cooper Station. Per our previous commitment, the District will forward the plan and procedures on January 15, 1982. By previous discussion with your staff, the District noted the logistical difficulty the Region would have in meeting an exercise date of January 20 assuming the current plan and procedures submittal date. Unfortunately, due to the length of the Fall 1981 Outage and the preparation time required for responding to the Appraisal Report, the District was unable to accelerate its submittal schedule. Therefore, the District has opted to pursue delaying the exercise until March, 1982 to allow your staff adequate preparation time. The State of Nebraska has indicated that primary and alternate dates of March 10 and March 17 are acceptable with the local and state agencies as well as the Federal Emergency Management Agency. Discussions with Mr. C. Hackney of your staff have likewise indicated that these dates appear to be acceptable. The District will, therefore, submit a revised set of exercise objectives during February 1982.
