



Dear Sir:

Philadelphia Electric Company is pleased to offer comments on a proposed change to Section 50.51 which would extend the operating life of nuclear power plants.

Philadelphia Electric Company is of the opinion that the petition's first alternative, providing an expiration date of the Operating License forty years from the date of its issuance, should be adopted. This proposed change would not alter the requirements for safe operation of nuclear plants, but merely restore the actual length of permitted operation to the design life of the components and materials used in plant construction. Decisions made in the construction of Limerick Units 1 and 2 were predicated upon a design life of forty years. Under current rules Limerick Unit 1 would have a permitted operating life of only twenty-nine years, an unjustified penalty if its operating license is received in 1984.

Philadelphia Electric Company urges the Commission to adopt this change to allow the safe, useful, economic operation of nuclear plants for the life which they were initially designed.
