




Dear Mr. Hartman:



A review of the two transcripts reveals that the relevant Commission deliberations on October 27 and 28, 1981 reflect discussions of matters relating to accusations of criminal violations and formal agency enforcement action, reasonably anticipated agency adjudication and litigation, and individual privicy. Further, certain matters discussed at the meeting involve information still subject to investigation and evaluation. Because of these factors, the Commission has determined that the public interest does not require release of these transcripts at this time.

Accordingly, the transcript of the Commission's meetings of October 27 and 28, 1981 are being withheld in their entirety pursuant to exemptions 5, 6 and 10 of the Government in the Sunshine Act. 5 U.S.C. 552b(c)(5), (6) and (10). Under the Sunshine Act, this denial may be appealed to the federal district court for the District of Columbia. 5 U.S.C. 552b(h) and (k).
