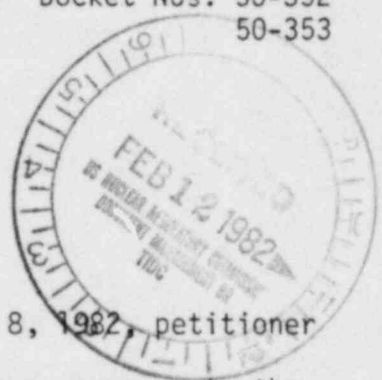

MEMORANDUM AND ORDER GRANTING
LEA LEAVE TO RESPOND TO NEW NRC
STAFF OBJECTIONS TO CONTENTIONS



For good cause shown by its motion of February 8, 1982, petitioner Limerick Ecology Action (LEA), is given leave to file a response to the new objections made by the NRC Staff in its response of February 2 to the clarification of certain Probabilistic Risk Assessment contentions. The clarification was jointly filed by LEA and the Keystone Alliance on January 18, 1982. Any response which Keystone seeks to make to the Staff's new objections shall be included in a joint response served by Petitioners by February 17, 1982.

In the future, a party seeking leave to file a discretionary response to a pleading normally should solicit and include the position on the request for leave of the party to which it is responding and the NRC Staff and Applicant.
