Semiannual Effluent and Waste Disposal Report



Appendix B of the Crystal River Unit 3 Technical Specifications requires Florida Power Corporation to prepare and submit a report on radioactive discharges released from the site, during the prior six months, within sixty (60) days of January 1 and July 1 each year. Due to a malfunction of the meteorological magnetic data recording equipment, meteorological data necessary to complete the effluent report must be obtained from strip chart recordings. Since this data reduction is not expected to be complete before late April, 1982, Florida Power Corporation estimates the earliest the next Semiannual Effluent and Waste Disposal Report can be submitted is June 1, 1982. Efforts to repair and maintain the magnetic recording system have been initiated.
