## SUBJECT: STEAM GENERATOR TUBE LEAK

Duke began a shutdown of the unit from full power at 8:54 a.m. (EST) today to repair a steam generator tube leak. The licensee estimates that repairs will take three weeks.

Indications of a leak had been detected for the past two days. The shutdown was begun after the leak rate reached 0.11 gallons per minute, which is below the technical specification limit of 1 gallon per minute.

The licensee expects the unit to reach hot shutdown by this afternoon and cold shutdown by 8:00 a.m. on February 10. The NRC resident inspector is monitoring the shutdown. Oconee Unit 2 is down for refueling, and Oconee Unit 3 is operating at full power.

Media interest is expected, since the licensee is issuing a news release. The NRC does not plan a news release. The State of South Carolina has been informed.
