In accordance with 10 CFR Part 50.59, we are enclosing 40 copies of a requested amendment to the licenses DPR-77 and DPR-79 to change the technical specifications for Sequoyah Nuclear Plant units 1 and 2 (Enclosure 1). The proposed amendment requests changes in the fire hose hydrostatic test pressure, maximum isolation times for valves in Table 3.6-2, ice bed temperature determination and the surveillance requirements for vital battery testing. Justifications to support the proposed changes are also provided (Enclosure 2).

In accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR Part 170.22, we have determined the proposed amendment to be Class II for unit 1 and Class I for unit 2. These classifications are based on the facts that the amendment is administrative in nature and that the changes apply to two identical units on the same site. The remittance fee of \$1,600 is being wired to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Attention: Licensing Fee Management Branch.
