WHEREAS, THE Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Environmental Resources, (DER), has raised a question of notice regarding its certification of NWRA's application to construct a pumping station; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above facts, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. DER, appellee herein, issue and file with this this Board its withdrawal of the certification previously issued to NWRA, the grant of which certification is the subject matter of this appeal.

2. DER shall cause to be issued in the Pennsylvania Bulletin issue of February 6, 1982, its withdrawal of the certification previously issued to NWRA.

3. Appellant, Delaware Unlimited, Inc., and appellee, NWRA, shall file with this Board appropriate motions or petitions within ten (10) days of the appearance of notice to appeal in the February 6, 1982, issue of the Pennsylvania Bulletin.

Section 401 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act:

The following requests have been made to the Department of Environmental Resources for certification pursuant to §401(a) of the 1972 amendments to the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, 33 U.S.C. §1341(a), that there is reasonable assurance that the construction herein described will not violate applicable federal and state water quality standards.

Prior to final approval of the proposed certification, consideration will be given to any comments/suggestions/objections which are submitted in writing within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. Comments should be submitted to the Department of Environmental Resources at the address indicated above each of the following requests for certification. All comments should contain the name, address, and telephone number of the person commenting, identification of the certification request to which the comments/objections are addressed, and a concise statement of comments/objections/suggestions in sufficient detail to inform the Department of the exact basis of the proposal and the relevant facts upon which it is based. The Department may conduct a fact-finding hearing or an informal conference in response to any given comments if deemed necessary to resolve conflicts. Each individual will be notified in writing of the time and place of any scheduled hearing or conference concerning the certification request to which the protest relates. Maps, drawings, and other data pertinent to the certification request are available for inspection and review at the address indicated above each request for certification between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. on each working day.
