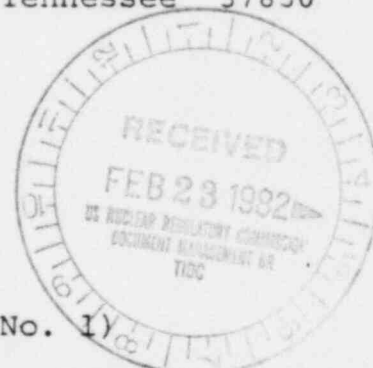

has proposed for the Licensing Board's consideration here


