Dear Mr. Linehan:

As discussed with you on the telephone, Western Nuclear, Inc. requests the transfer of Materials License SUA-1337 from the present Licensee, J & P Corporation, P.O. Box 114, Casper, Wyoming 82601, to Western Nuclear, Inc., 134 Union Boulevard, #640, Lakewood, Colorado 80228.

The details of the transaction follow. Western Nuclear, Inc. has a 50% interest in the Christensen Ranch solution mining project and has held this interest for some time. As you were informed by Mr. Peter I. Wold, Vice President, J & P Corporation, J & P sold 100% of its right, title, and interest in the Christensen Ranch solution mining project to the Arizona Public Service Co. Arizona Public Service Co. and Western Nuclear agreed to designate Western Nuclear as the Licensee through transfer of the license. The project will be operated by Western Nuclear, Inc. personnel. As far as WNI is aware, J & P has no objections to the transfer of the license.

Western Nuclear is prepared to accept all obligations and responsibilities as included in the existing license.


It was also discussed with you on the telephone there are certain changes in the license conditions required by WNI and there are certain updating changes to be required by NRC which will be handled through the license amendment process.


