NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Mississippi Power and Light Company Grand Gulf 1

As a result of the inspection conducted on November 30 - December 4, 1981, and in accordance with the Interim Enforcement Policy, 45 FR 66754 (October 7, 1980), the following violation was identified.

10 CFR 50, Appendix B, Criterion X and the implementing section of the Operational Quality Assurance Manual, MP&L - Topical-1, paragraph 10.4.2 requires that all safety-related work authorizations be reviewed by the Plant Quality Supervisor for determination of any quality inspection requirements. Plant Procedure 07-S-01-6, Rev. 2, Conduct of Maintenance Activities, Section 6.2.2(h) states that the Plant Quality Superintendent will perform a quality review of all safety-related Maintenance Work Orders (MWO's), sign and date the MWO, and return to the appropriate Maintenance Planner.

Contrary to the above, during the period of May 11 and September 16, 1981, safety related work was performed on the HPCS diesel generator system using the non-safety-related MWO-005228, which was issued on April 21, 1981, to primarily document craft labor in support of the system run-in of system P81-HPCS Diesel Generator. This action bypassed the reviews and controls established to ensure quality control checks as specified above.

This is a Severity Level V Violation (Supplement II.E).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are hereby required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) admission or denial of the alleged violation; (2) the reasons for the violation if admitted; (3) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (4) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (5) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown. Under the authority of Section 182 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, this response shall be submitted under oath or affirmation.
