NUREG-0737 Item III.D.3.3 requires each licensee to improve in-plant iodine instrumentation under accident conditions. We only reviewed deviations to the stated positions of NUREG-0737.

Based on our review of your submittals, no technical deviations from our stated positions were requested for Crystal River Unit 3. Therefore, we interpret this to mean that you will meet the position, and no further review by NRR is planned. If this understanding is not correct, we request formal notification of such, within 30 days of the date of this letter.
