Page 2, Section 6.1

6.1 General

Coordination and general supervision of the annual radiation emergency medical exercise shall be provided by REMS Corporation and the Toledo Edison Emergency Planning Group.

Page 2, Section 6.2.1

6.2.1 Annually, REMS Corporation shall consult with the Emergency Planning and Preparedness Supervisor and select a date that is mutually convenient for the annual radiation emergency medical exercise.

Page 2, Section 6.2.2

6.2.2 REMS Corporation shall initiate coordination of subsequent exercises NOT later than one week preceding the anniversary calendar quarter of the previous year's exercise.

Page 2, Section 6.2.3

6.2.3 NOT less than two months prior to an exercise, REMS Corporation shall submit an exercise scenario to the Emergency Planning and Preparedness Supervisor for approval.

Page 2, Section 6.2.5

6.2.5 Station personnel, and REMS Corporation shall present a training program to members of the Station Staff within approximately two weeks prior to the annual exercise.

Page 2, Section 6.2.7

6.2.7 The Lead Medical Coordinator and REMS Corporation shall present a training program to members of the Magruder Memorial Hospital and the Carroll Township Emergency Medical Service staff within approximately two weeks prior to the annual exercise.

Page 3, Section 6.2.9

6.2.9 In accordance with agreements among the Station Superintendent, Emergency Planning Supervisor, Lead Medical Coordinator, the Magruder Memorial Hospital Administrator, and REMS Corporation, umpires for the exercise shall be appointed.

To meet the requirements of the Station Emergency Plan, its implementing procedures, and OSHA Standards, the following describes the organization of, and details the manning for first aid response activities at DBNPS.

I. ORGANIZATION

During Normal Working Hours

1. Station First Aid Team

- 1 - First Aid Team Leader
- 3 or more First Aid Team Members as required

Alternates: one each for -  
First Aid Team Leader  
First Aid Team Member

During Off-Normal Working Hours

2. (The duty operating shift)

- FAT Leader - Assist. Shift Supervisor
- \*3 FAT Members -  
Equipment Operator(s) and/or  
Auxiliary Operator(s)

Alternates: Leader - Shift Supervisor or  
qualified management person  
\*Member(s) - Reactor Operator

\*To be designated by duty Shift Supervisor

1. During Normal Working Hours - The response for First Aid Members may be utilized, as necessary. The Operating Shift, in general, will not be involved unless circumstances so dictate.
2. During Off-Normal Working Hours, Weekends & Holidays - The Operating Shift will function as the First Aid Team.

NOTE: During the immediacy of the moment - in the absence of a First Aid Team Leader - a Team Member, who has met the qualifications for First Aid Team Leader (AD 1827.02, "Medical Treatment of Injuries", Sec. 3.7) can and should perform such function, so as to ensure prompt and proper care for the injured.
