Dear Mr. Fay:

In our letter of January 7, 1982, we requested additional information concerning equipment qualification. Specifically, we requested that copies of references noted in your response to the staff's Safety Evaluation concerning Environmental Qualification of Safety Related Electrical Equipment be mailed directly to our contractor Franklin Research Center (FRC) with a copy of the transmittal letter out to the staff.

You responded to our request by letter dated January 29, 1982. In your response, you identified two references, p and z which you were not sending to FRC due to their proprietary nature. You indicated that these items were available for audit by NRC or FRC staff at your corporate offices.

It is our request that you send references p and z, or copies thereof, to the NRC staff for review, "Attention: Zoltan R. Rosztoczy, Chief, Equipment Qualification Branch" by the most expeditious method available. As discussed with members of your staff, the transmittal letter should include the proprietary claim for the documents (which should be stamped as proprietary) and a statement of your plan for completion of the remaining applicable sections of 10 CFR 2.790. Upon receipt, these documents will be treated as proprietary. Questions regarding this request can be directed to your project manager or to Mr. Ed Shomaker, staff attorney at (301) 492-8653.

We have also determined that we will need the additional information identified in the enclosure to this letter to continue our review of those equipments relating to TMI Action Plan Items. These items have been discussed with members of your staff. Your response is requested within 30 days of the date of this letter. It is also requested that a copy of your response be sent directly to FRC, mailing address attached.

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
