Gentlemen:

This refers to the special safety inspection conducted by Mr. J. F. Norton of this office on January 19, 1982, of activities at D. C. Cook Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2, authorized by NRC Operating Licenses No. DPR-58 and No. DPR-74 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. W. G. Smith, Jr. and others at the conclusion of the inspection.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. The inspection consisted of a review of American Electric Power Service Corporation responses to IE Bulletin No. 80-11. The information required by the Bulletin, has not been completely addressed in responses to date. Section 7 of the report identifies the information that is needed. This information is requested by April 30, 1982 to permit timely technical evaluation of structural design/construction integrity. Please notify us if you can not meet this date.

No items of noncompliance with NRC requirements were identified during the course of this inspection.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room. If this report contains any information that you (or your contractors) believe to be exempt from disclosure under 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4), it is necessary that you (a) notify this office by telephone within ten (10) days from the date of this letter of your intention

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to file a request for withholding; and (b) submit within twenty-five (25) days from the date of this letter a written application to this office to withhold such information. If your receipt of this letter has been delayed such that less than seven (7) days are available for your review, please notify this office promptly so that a new due date may be established. Consistent with Section 2.790(b)(1), any such application must be accompanied by an affidavit executed by the owner of the information which identifies the document or part sought to be withheld, and which contains a full statement of the reasons which are the bases for the claim that the information should be withheld from public disclosure. This section further requires the statement to address with specificity the considerations listed in 10 CFR 2.790(b)(4). The information sought to be withheld shall be incorporated as far as possible into a separate part of the affidavit. If we do not hear from you in this regard within the specified periods noted above, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the Public Document Room.

We will gladly discuss any questions you have concerning this inspection.
