CONDITIONS

Amendment No. 1

This license is amended to:

- (1) Increase the quantity of material authorized for import from 15 kilograms Uranium containing 0.49 kilograms U-235 enriched to 3.5% to 150 kilograms uranium containing 5.3 kilograms U-235 enriched to 3.5% (this represents an increase of 135 kilograms uranium and 4.81 kilograms U-235);
- (2) Extend the expiration date from April 1, 1982 to December 31, 1983; and
- (3) Change Condition 3 to read:
Each time material is imported, the licensee shall show a copy of the license to U.S. Customs as authority for the import.

All other conditions remain unchanged.
