UCS/NYPIRG MOTION FOR AN EXPEDITED ORDER ON STANDING AND COMMENCING DISCOVERY

In its Order of September 18, 1981, the Commission requested that it receive the Board's recommendations after the hearing within one year, or by September 18, 1982. The Union of Concerned Scientists and the New York Public Interest Research Group, Inc. respectfully submit that, particularly with respect to the emergency planning issues, it is in the interest of the public that the hearing process begin as soon as possible. The Board's recommendations with respect to emergency planning, and the Commissions actions on those recommendations will affect the health and safety of all of the population residing near the Indian Point nuclear power plants, both within and outside the ten-mile plume exposure pathway emergency planning zone.
