While I will not be able to attend the licensing hearing for the Fermi 2 nuclear power plant, as I and many of my neighbors have to work, I do wish to register my strong opposition to the licensing of Fermi 2 as a nuclear facility.

Not only is the plant a constant threat to us with its now planned and unplanned radiation releases (whose adverse health effects are cumulative) but every time the plant encounters technical problems it is much more costly and time-consuming to correct the problem in a nuclear plant. The people of Michigan cannot afford to construct, maintain, insure and decommission these dangerous white elephants any longer.
