5. The following activities under your license (identified in Item No. 3 above) appear to be in noncompliance with AEC regulations or license requirements, as indicated.			
<p>Contrary to 10 CFR 20.201(b), "Surveys", evaluations of the airborne concentrations of thorium have not in all cases, been adequate to show compliance with 10 CFR 20.103, "Exposure of individuals to concentrations of radioactive materials in restricted areas", and compliance with 10 CFR 20.106, "Concentrations in effluents to unrestricted areas", in that air samples taken in the restricted areas and of stack effluents, and assayed at the Pittsburgh office of Westinghouse Corporation were not evaluated with respect to the limits specified in 10 CFR 20.103; and in that no determination was made to establish that the anisokinetic samples collected from the stack were representative of the effluent to the unrestricted areas.</p>
