Westinghouse management at the Bloomfield, New Jersey plant seems to need a certain amount of prodding by AEC in order to achieve adequate control over their licensed operations. This attitude is explained, in large measure, by the fact that the RSO is an industrial safety man whose qualifications as a health physicist leave much to be desired.

In view of the assurances of Mr. Millbank, to the effect that he can and will see that survey reports are reviewed by a knowledgable individual, the health and safety aspects of the operation are considered marginally acceptable.

This program is properly classified Category E, Priority III. It is recommended that the next inspection be scheduled in six months; May, 1971.
