Dear Mr. Thompson:

On September 26, 1986, you provided the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Region III Office with information indicating the former Director of Nuclear Security at the Detroit Edison Company's Fermi Nuclear Plant may have furnished incomplete information to the Region III staff. The Region III Office processed your information as an allegation and forwarded your concerns to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Office of Investigations for followup.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the Office of Investigations has administratively closed the investigation due to a lack of investigator resources. While the potential wrongdoing aspect of your concerns was not investigated, the Region III Office did review the technical aspects of your concerns. Unfortunately I cannot provide you with a copy of the documentation pertaining to the Region III review of your concerns since those documents contain specific information pertaining to the physical security of the Fermi Plant. As such, that information is exempt from public disclosure under the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's rules and regulations. However, I can assure you that the Region III Office has reviewed your concerns and all of the technical aspects have been resolved.

Your cooperation with us in this matter was appreciated.
