Fitness-For-Duty Program Implementation

Gentlemen:

As required by 10CFR26, Section 26.73(d), this letter certifies that Louisiana Power & Light Company Waterford 3 is implementing a fitness-for-duty program that meets the requirements of 10CFR26. The effective date of implementation will be January 3, 1990.

Waterford 3 will utilize initial test cut-off levels (ng/ml) as described in 10CFR26, Appendix A, Paragraph 2.7(e)(1) except the initial cut-off level for marijuana metabolite will be 50ng/ml instead of 100ng/ml. We will report data under both cut-off levels when submitting the Fitness-For-Duty Program Performance Data as required by 10CFR26, Paragraph 26.71(d). No additional drugs will be tested for at this time.

Waterford 3 will conduct initial on-site screening as provided by 10CFR26, Paragraph 26.24(d).
