Gentlemen:

This acknowledges receipt of your letters of January 4 and March 2, 1990, by which you transmitted Revision 25 to the Cooper Nuclear Station Safeguards Plan. Your letter of January 4 provided changes to the Plan in response to our review of Revision 24. Subsequently, in the March 2 letter, NPPD provided a complete Revision 25 which included the changes transmitted in the January 4 letter. In discussions with your staff we have confirmed that the March 2, 1990, submittal is the complete and current Revision 25 to the Plan.

We have reviewed the current Revision 25 and have determined that the changes therein do not decrease the effectiveness of the plan. Accordingly, we thereby find that the current Revision 25 to the Cooper Nuclear Station Safeguards Plan to be the operational security plan for Cooper Nuclear Station.

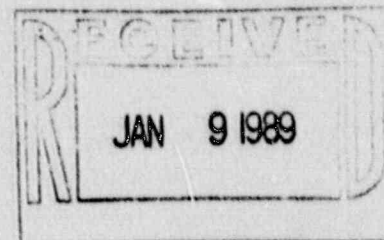

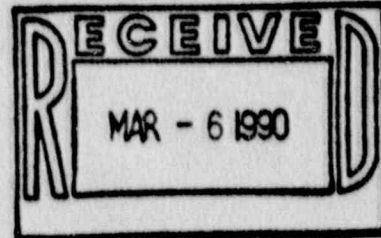


