Dear Mr. Peterson:

Advanced Nuclear Fuels Corporation (ANF) requests that the reference license be extended for five years with the new expiration date becoming June 30, 1995.

In addition, ANF requests that the amount of nuclear material authorized for export be increased to 2,600 kg U-235 contained in 61,600 kg total uranium to satisfy the requirements of a contract for four additional reloads for the Barsebäck power plant in Sweden.

This additional material will bring the total authorization for the Barsebäck plant to 5,230 kg U-235 contained in 128,510 kg total uranium. The total authorized by the referenced license becomes 6,680 kg U-235 contained in 172,650 kg total uranium. The origin of the uranium is unknown at this time.
