Thank you for your letter dated April 25, 1990, in response to our March 19, 1990 letter concerning allegations pertaining to violations of regulations regarding overtime at Fermi 2 (Allegation RIII-89-A-0142).

In our letter we requested that you review the circumstances surrounding the allegation and submit the results of your investigation to the NRC.

Your response indicated that the allegation was not substantiated, based on a review of work hours for Nuclear Power Plant Operators and interviews with operators.

We found your investigation to be sufficient to support your conclusions and have no additional questions regarding this matter. We request that you retain the supporting documentation for your investigation of this allegation for a minimum of one year from the date of this letter.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
