SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO NRC GENERIC LETTER 89-06 ON THE SAFETY PARAMETER DISPLAY

SYSTEM (MPA F-072, TAC NOS. 73672 AND 73673)

RE: LIMERICK GENERATING STATION, UNIT NOS. 1 AND 2

NRC Generic Letter (GL) 89-06, dated April 12, 1990, requested you to provide certification regarding the implementation of a Safety Parameter Display System (SPDS) at your facility. The GL and its attachment, NUREG-1342, provided clarification of the requirements for an aceptable SPDS as originally defined in NUREG-0737. Supplement 1, issued January 1983. The GL further requested you to complete a checklist and take photographs of your SPDS and to retain these records for three years from the date of certification.

Your letter of July 11, 1989 certified that the SPDS at Limerick Unit 1 meets the requirements of NUREG-0737. Supplement 1 taking into account the guidance provided in NUREG-1342. As proposed in your letter of December 5, 1988 and approved by the staff in Supplement 8 to the SER (NUREG-0991, SSER8), the report on the Unit 2 SPDS was to be submitted within 30 days after the Unit 2 SPDS was declared operational. Your letter of February 15, 1990 verified that the Unit 2 SPDS meets the requirements of NUREG-0737, Supplement 1 taking into account the guidance provided in NUREG-1342.

Based upon this certification, the NRC staff concludes that the Limerick Generating Station, Units 1 and 2, has satisfactorily met all the requirements for an SPDS specified in NUREG-0737. Supplement 1. Therefore, staff review and licensee implementation of the SPDS are considered complete for your facility.
