If the commitments and corrective actions described are accurate, please acknowledge this in writing to us within 30 days of this letter. Your reply should also include a description and schedule of the corrective action you plan for the exercise weakness addressing the inadequate accountability identified in Paragraph 11. If your understanding of the commitments and/or corrective action differs from that presented, please let us know immediately.

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In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
