I do not object to the approach that the staff has recommended in SECY-90-137, with the understanding that whatever steps are ultimately taken in the area of maintenance will lead to maintenance programs that -- (1) provide for the identification of problematic equipment, the conduct of root cause analysis, the tracking of corrective actions, and the continuing feedback of information; and (2) provide a mechanism for the NRC to verify program effectiveness.

I also agree with Commissioner Roberts' comments on the staff's schedule for submitting its recommendations on the need for further rulemaking.
