Gent lemen:

Our letter dated May 16, 1990, submitted Technical Specifications Change Request No. 90-11-1 requesting a change to the Technical Specifications (TS) Surveillance Requirement 4.7.4b to allow a one-time extension of the snubber visual inspection period. Since the current inspection period plus the 25% grace period expires on July 14, 1990, the proposed change was needed to avoid a shutdown of Unit 1 prior to the scheduled refueling outage in September 1990, in order to perform the required reduced interval visual inspection of three snubbers located in the drywell.

The proposed change is no longer needed since Unit 1 was shutdown on June 5, 1990, and the visual inspection of the three affected snubbers has subsequently been performed on June 7, 1990, within the required surveillance interval, and the acceptance criteria were satisfied. Accordingly, we request that our TS Change Request No. 90-11-1, submitted by our letter dated May 16, 1990, be withdrawn.
