Dear Sir:

The following is my respone in reply to the notice of violation found by the inspection on April 30 and May 1, 1990, at the facility of license No. 34-190007-01MD.

Violation 1. Failure to evaluate I-131 air sample filters on those days when liquid I-131 was dispensed or therapy capsules were compounded.

Corrective Action: Air sample filters will be evaluated every day, regardless if liquid 1-131 is handled. This action will also prevent any further re-occurrence as it will no longer be necessary to remember if liquid I-131 was handled or not. It will be a daily routine function.

Date of Full Compliance was 5/1/90.


Violation 2. Weekly vehicle surveys were not performed as required.

Corrective Action: Failure to perform the surveys were due to the reponsible person's exployment terminated and another time was due the responsible person on vacation. To prevent further re-occurrence, a list of these functions will be drawn up that then can be assigned to another individual when the primary person is not working for whatever reason.

Date of Full Compliance: Surveys are now in compliance. List of duties to be drawn up by 6/30/90.

Violation 2. Failed to include the transport index on the

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shipping paper submitted with a package.

Corrective Action: The transport index was left off the shipping paper due to unfamiliarity with the carrier's form. To prevent further violations, a sample form will be posted in the dispatching area so that all necessary information will be included.
