On April 23, 1990, New Hampshire Yankee (NHY) submitted a proposed amendment to the Facility Operating License No. NPF-86 regarding the sale and leaseback of a portion of The United ILluminating Company's (UI) ownership share in Seabrook Station Unit No. 1 (Reference (b)).
