Dear Mr. Grimes:

Westinghouse is in receipt of your letter of May 8, 1990.

I can assure you that Westinghouse is fully cognizant of and acts in full accordance with its responsibilities pursuant to the rules and regulations of the U.S. Nuclear Regulation Commission.

Based on our knowledge, including any information contained in the filed complaint, there are no previously unreported conditions which would be reportable under 10CFR21. If the utilities were aware of such conditions, they would be required pursuant to 10CFR21 to notify NRC of any such conditions. Moreover, if conditions were identified by the utilities where the safety significance could not be evaluated without the participation of the vendor, Westinghouse would expect to be provided such information. Westinghouse has not been given such information, nor has Westinghouse been asked to participate in or provide facts in order to assist such an evaluation.

We will consider any new information obtained by Westinghouse consistent with its responsibility pursuant to the NRC rules and regulations.
