In 1991, Troxler Electronic Laboratories, Inc., strongly opposed the increase in NRC fees to our industry. This represented a 393% fee increase for an average customer who experienced routine inspections.

Data from 1992 indicates that the number of licensees in the 3P category decreased by 25%. This number is significant because it represents many small business owners who can no longer do the testing required to build highways and roads in the United States for the federal or state governments. The average proposed fee for a 5-year license with one inspection and two amendments brings the cost to approximately \$2700 per year. The fees are excessive and are an unfair burden to NRC licensees.

We urge you to respond to the request for Public Comment. If you are in agreement with this position, please complete and fax the transmittal below to Mr. Holloway at the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. You may copy this form letter to your letterhead if you wish.

To keep the NRC license fees under control, your immediate response is URGENT; it must be received by the NRC by May 24, 1993.
