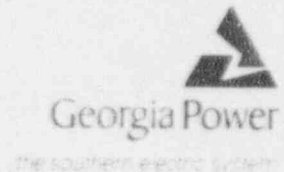


Gentlemen:

In accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.54(p)(2), Georgia Power Company (GPC) hereby submits a report of changes to the Physical Security Plan (PSP) for the Edwin I. Hatch Nuclear Plant - Units 1 and 2. The changes are administrative and editorial in nature, clarifying and enhancing wording to achieve consistency with actual plant conditions and programs.

Georgia Power Company has determined the enclosed changes do not decrease the effectiveness of the Plant Hatch Physical Security Plan. The changes and a justification for the determination of no decrease in Safeguards effectiveness are presented as Enclosure 1. Enclosure 2 contains the revised Physical Security Plan pages.

The information contained in Enclosures 1 and 2 is Safeguards information, and in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 73.71 and Section 147 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, should not be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
