As the chairman of the NRC, you have the ability to deny the LES' application to construct a uranium enrichment facility in Homer, Louisiana. I urge you to do so, for allowing this would be blatant environmental racism & classism. The proposed site is currently occupied by two low-income, predominantly black, rural communities, Forest Grove and Center Springs. 4,000 tons of U-238 radioactive waste would be generated annually and most likely contaminate the area during its half-life. There is already a worldwide overcapacity for producing enriched uranium, so there is no need to put these underprivileged neighbors at risk.
