As part of the resolution for Generic Safety Issue 106, your staff raised a concern associated with the 500 gallon propane tank located about 25 feet from the turbine building at Duane Arnold Energy Center (DAEC). The concern relates to the potential impact that this tank may have on the operation of the Emergency Diesel Generators during a seismic event. Reference 1 asked that we confirm in writing what we had told NRR orally.

This is to confirm that we will include the propane tank in DAEC's Individual Plant Examination of External Events (IPEEE). As described in Reference 2, completion of the IPEEE is scheduled for November 1995.
