Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 2  
Revision 11 to the Updated Final Safety Analysis Report

In 1982,<sup>(1)</sup> Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) submitted the initial updated Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR) for Millstone Unit No. 2 in fulfillment of the requirements of 10CFR50.71(e). That rule, as amended, further requires that subsequent revisions of the FSAR shall be filed annually, or six months after each refueling outage, provided the interval between successive updates to the FSAR does not exceed 24 months. The FSAR update shall reflect all changes up to a maximum of six months prior to the date of filing.<sup>(2)</sup>

NNECO hereby submits Revision 11 to the updated FSAR in the form of replacement pages as required. Pursuant to 10CFR50.71(e)(2)(i), I certify that this revision accurately presents changes completed since our previous submittal that are necessary to reflect information and analyses submitted to the Commission or prepared pursuant to Commission requirements as of December 31, 1992. I note, however, that there are ongoing design changes, and operability and technical evaluations which are pending and may lead to future FSAR updates. Pursuant to 10CFR50.71(e) and 10CFR50.4(b)(6), this transmittal consists of one original and ten copies.

As stipulated in 10CFR50.71(e)(2)(ii): "This submittal shall include an identification of changes made under the provisions of Section 50.59 but not

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
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previously submitted to the Commission." Pursuant to Section 50.59(b) and Technical Specification 6.9.1.4, such information is routinely submitted to the NRC as part of our annual reports, and is not included in this submittal. The most recent annual report was submitted on February 26, 1993,<sup>(3)</sup> for the period January 1, 1992, through December 31, 1992.

We trust that this information satisfies the requirements of 10CFR50.71(e).
