

Revision 1 to Voluntary Licensee Event Report 93-017
Extension of Feedwater Isolation Bypass Positioner
and Solenoid Beyond Equipment Qualification Life

Pursuant to 10CFR50.73, Houston Lighting & Power (HL&P) submits the attached revision to Unit 1 Voluntary Licensee Event Report 93-017 regarding extension of Feedwater Isolation Bypass Valve (FWIBV) positioner and solenoid beyond equipment qualification life. This event did not have an adverse effect on the health and safety of the public.

This revision documents HL&P's evaluation of the operability of the FWIBV positioners and solenoids. HL&P personnel concluded that the FWIBV positioner and solenoid qualified lives have not been exceeded. Based on these results, the event described in this LER would not be considered reportable per 10CFR50.73, and as such, this LER has been changed to a Voluntary LER. Changes are indicated by revision bars.

The Additional Information section of this Licensee Event Report contains HL&P's conclusions, regarding the FWIBV which was thought to be partially open since April 1992. HL&P concluded that the valve was actually closed.
