SUBJECT: NAVY SAFETY REPORT REVIEW

As you may be aware, the NRC, and specifically the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, is committed to review safety reports for the Navy. We are currently scheduled to review the latest Navy nuclear submarine design. This review will involve 58 people representing reviewers, project managers, NRR management, and support staff. At present, 26 people hold "L" clearances which must be upgraded. A table showing the organizational distribution of personnel involved is enclosed.

Because we will have a large number of staff members handling classified material, we discussed with the Division of Security possible approaches that would minimize the possibility of a security infraction. Based on these discussions, we recommend that a separate enclosed, lockable, room be assigned to us for this review. The equipment needed to support the review would be a safe, two computer systems modified for classified material, a laser printer, and a secure telephone unit.

To meet our schedule, we would like the room assigned and equipment ready by late June. Any questions concerning the review can be addressed to myself or the project manager for the review, Al Adams.
