Attached is the Limerick Generating Station (LGS), Units 1 and 2, 1993 Annual Emergency Preparedness Exercise scenario package for NRC review. This scenario package is being submitted 60 days prior to the scheduled September 29, 1993 annual exercise in accordance with an NRC letter dated August 9, 1989, regarding the submittal of "Emergency Exercise Objectives and Scenario Guidelines."
