Gentlemen:

Attached is Revision No. 0 of Philadelphia Electric Company's (PECo's) Nuclear Emergency Plan for Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station (PBAPS), Units 2 and 3. and Limerick Generating Station (LGS), Units 1 and 2. This Nuclear Emergency Plan consolidates the existing PBAPS, Units 2 and 3, and LGS, Units 1 and 2, emergency plans into one common emergency plan for both facilities. In accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q), we have evaluated the changes associated with consolidating the PBAPS and LGS emergency plans into the common Nuclear Emergency Plan and have determined that the changes do not decrease the effectiveness of the individual plans, and that this common Nuclear Emergency Plan continues to meet the requirements of 10 CFR 50.47(b) and 10 CFR 50, Appendix E. This Nuclear Emergency Plan has been reviewed by the PBAPS and LGS Plant Operations Review Committees.

In addition, by letter dated March 18, 1993, PECo submitted a draft copy of the Nuclear Emergency Plan for NRC review. Based on a telephone conversation between Mr. R. Kinard (PECo) and Mr. J. Laughlin (NPC Region I) on July 16, 1993, the NRC indicated that they completed their review of the draft Nuclear Emergency Plan, and that consolidating the Plan did not decrease the effectiveness of each site's emergency plan. In a subsequent conversation between Mr. R. Kinard and Mr. J. Laughlin on July 27, 1993, the NRC indicated that the discussions held on July 16, 1993, would serve as an endorsement of the common Nuclear Emergency Plan and that no formal written correspondence would be provided.

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Also attached, is Revision No. 1 to the Nuclear Emergency Plan. This revision is comprised of administrative changes to Appendix E, "Emergency Supplies and Equipment," intended to clarify the location of equipment for use by the field survey groups. We have evaluated these changes and have determined that they do not decrease the effectiveness of the common Nuclear Emergency Plan.

Accordingly, Revision Nos. 0 and 1 of this common Nuclear Emergency Plan for PBAPS, Units 2 and 3, and LGS, Units 1 and 2, are being submitted within 30 days of their implementation in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q), 10 CFR 50Appendix E, and 10 CFR 50.4(b)(5).
