Subject: Combined Inspection 50-277/80-18 and 50-278/80-10

This refers to your letter dated January 29, 1982, in response to our letter dated December 30, 1981.

Thank you for providing us the supplemental information regarding your corrective and preventive actions documented in your June 5, 1981 response to the combined inspection. These actions will be examined during a future inspection of your licensed program.

Regarding Items A.1, B.1, B.5 and C.2.a of your letter, based on a March 12, 1982 telephone conversation between Mr. W. Knapp of your staff and Mr. R. Nimitz of this office:

- the job position descriptions for all positions in the Health Physics group and the Radioactive Waste Supervisor will be completed by May 28, 1982. (Items A.1 and B.5);
- a formally documented Health Physics professional level training and retraining program will be established by January 1, 1983. (Items B.1 and B.5); and
- the whole body counter check now includes a quantitative calibration check. (Item C.2.a)


