This letter is to acknowledge receipt on March 22, 1982, of your letter dated March 12, 1982, and the attachment FOSAVEX-82

I request that you review 10 CFR 50, Appendix E.IV.F., which reflects exercising your emergency capabilities.

The following comments should be reflected in your Scope:

Item 4

Full demonstration of the EWA to include notification of the State, activation of the EWA, and follow-up message by the EBS.

Item 5

Definition of key emergency response personnel which should include; i.e., the fire brigade, offsite monitoring teams, onsite monitoring teams, corrective action teams and security.

The following comments should be included in your Objective:

Demonstrate that the State, local and other response organizations can alert and notify emergency response personnel.
