Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. J. P. Jaudon and E. H. Johnson of our staff during the period February 22-26, 1982, of activities authorized by NRC Facility Operating License DPR-40 for the Fort Calhoun Station, and to the discussion of our findings by the inspectors with you and members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection

Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities were not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements. Consequently, you are required to respond to this matter, in writing, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Violation enclosed with this letter.

We have also examined actions you have taken with regard to previously identified inspection findings. The status of these items is identified in paragraph 2 of the enclosed report. Your attention is invited specifically to one of these items. This is the item concerning actions to prevent potential compromise of operator requalification examinations. This is a most sensitive subject, and you are, therefore, requested to respond to this item at the same time that you respond to the enclosed Notice of Violation. Your response to this item should address either the actions you have taken (or will take) or your reasons for not taking action in this area.

Three new unresolved items are discussed in paragraph 4 of the enclosed report.
